

Curtin Kalgoorlie Open Day Registration Competition 2026 – Terms and Conditions

1. Instructions on how to enter and other details contained within promotional advertisements for the Curtin Kalgoorlie Open Day Competition 2026 (“the competition”) form part of these Terms and Conditions.
2. By entering the competition, entrants agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.
3. The Terms and Conditions of the competition are governed by the laws of the State of Western Australia.
4. The competition is being run by Curtin University, GPO Box U1987, Perth, Western Australia, 6845 (“Curtin University”).
5. The competition opens at 10.00 am Australian Western Standard Time (“AWST”) on Thursday, 2 July 2026.
6. The closing time for entering the competition is 5.00 pm AWST on Thursday 27 August 2026.
7. To enter the competition, the entrant must:
 - a) register their contact details via the Kalgoorlie Open Day website (curtin.edu.au/events/kal-openday);
 - b) opt-in to receive further communications from Curtin; and
 - c) be available to collect the prize in person at the Curtin University Kalgoorlie campus during office hours of 8.30am – 4.30pm and within seven (7) working days following the prize draw.
8. All personal information collected in relation to the competition will be handled in accordance with Curtin University’s Privacy Statement (https://informationmanagement.curtin.edu.au/privacy/#Privacy_Statement).
9. Entry to the competition is free. Entrants will be responsible for all costs associated with entering the competition, which may include costs associated with accessing the internet.
10. Entrants may only enter the competition once.
11. Staff employed by Curtin University and their immediate family members are not eligible to enter the competition.
12. There will be one (1) prize. This prize will be a Nintendo Switch Console.
13. There will be one (1) draw at 9:00 am Australian Western Standard Time on Friday 28 July 2026 in building 100, Curtin, Kent Street, Bentley, 6102. The draw will be conducted by assigning all entrants a number and then using the Random Integer Generator to draw a winning number/ entrant.
14. The prize winner will be contacted within seven (7) days of the draw by the email address supplied in the registration form.

15. If the prize winner does not respond to claim the prize within 21 days of the draw, a re-draw will be conducted within 30 days of the original draw date, in the same location, and with the same method. Redraws will continue in the same manner until all prizes have been claimed by prize winners.
16. If the prize winner is under the age of 18 years, the prize will be awarded to the winner's legal guardian.
17. The prize must be collected in person by the prize winner or parent/legal guardian from Curtin University Kalgoorlie campus.
18. The prize winner, or if under the age of 18 years their legal guardian, may be required to provide evidence of their identity (such as photographic ID, birth certificate or current passport) when receiving the prize.
19. The prize winner will be responsible for all costs associated with collecting and using the prize.
20. By entering the competition, the entrant agrees that they are over the age of 18 years, or if under the age of 18 years, have their legal guardian's consent to enter the competition.
21. Curtin University is not responsible in any manner whatsoever for any problems or any financial costs incurred, or any combination thereof, including any injury or damage to participants or any other persons related to or resulting from participation in this competition.

Curtin University accepts no responsibility and shall not be held legally liable or responsible for any accident, loss, injury or damage to any individual or property whether direct or indirect, whether in contract, tort, negligence or otherwise arising out of or in connection with the competition or the prize, either during or after the competition.
23. Entry into the competition signifies acceptance of all conditions. Entrants are required to abide by the Terms and Conditions as presented.
24. Curtin University's decision will be final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
25. Entrants acknowledge and agree that if a prize is unavailable, for whatever reason, Curtin University reserves the right to substitute the prize for a prize of equal or greater value. Entrants also acknowledge and agree that prizes are not transferrable or exchangeable, and prizes cannot be taken as cash.
